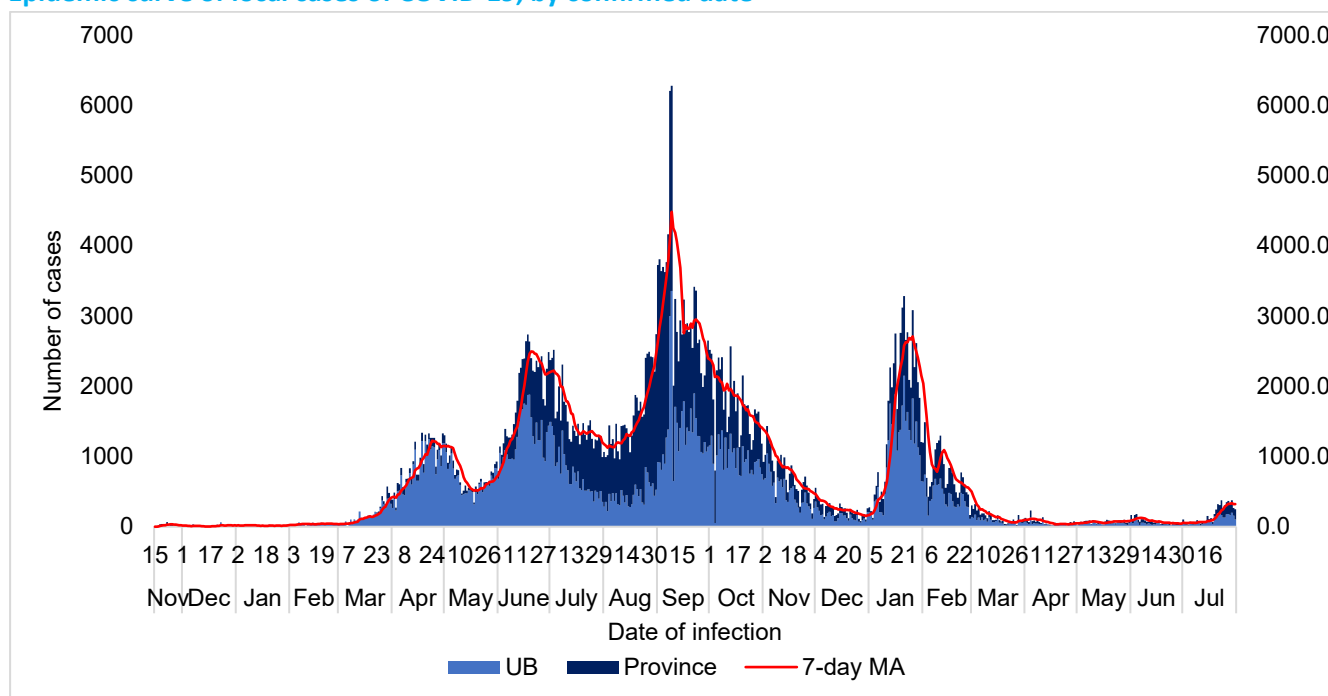


## Situation summary in Mongolia

- 2167 cases confirmed in the past week
- 1100 cases confirmed in UB, and 1067 cases confirmed in all 21 provinces in the past seven days
- Mild 285, moderate 1589, severe 183 and 20 critical cases are under medical treatment
- HCWs infection is 1.7% (16,124 cases) of all the confirmed cases. 46(39.3%) of 117 new cases in the past week are community acquired infections.
- Activated bed management team to manage triaging, severity of hospitalized cases to treat right patients in right settings
- Added hospital beds and ICU beds.
- Established COVID-19 outpatient centers with X-ray in all districts and provinces to monitor.

## Epidemic curve of local cases of COVID-19, by confirmed date

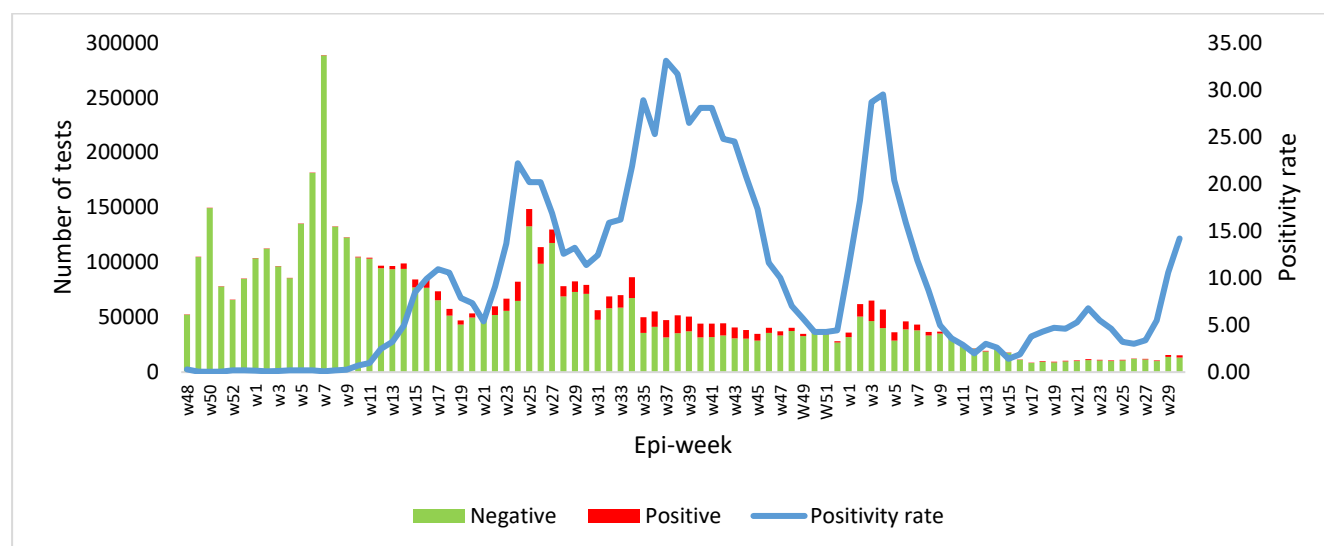

## Immunization

- As of 24<sup>th</sup> July 2022, the coverage of 1<sup>st</sup> dose is 96.5% (2,273,956), 2<sup>nd</sup> dose – 92.4% (2,177,347) in the target population.
- In Ulaanbaatar and 21 provinces, 1,051,339 and 136,519 people were vaccinated with the 3rd and 4th doses of AstraZeneca and Pfizer.
- Since the start of vaccination 472,314 (8%) vaccinated people have been confirmed to be infected with the coronavirus.

## PHSM

- Heightened state of alert level II has been reduced to level I start from 14 Feb 2022 except for vaccinations, wearing masks, and social distancing:
  - Restaurants, bars, and cafes with designated premises are open until 05:00 am
  - Dedicated shops and restaurants can operate 24/7
- 10 soums of 8 provinces with PoE are in alert level II.
- All travelers no need pre-travel test max 72 hours before departure since 14 March. No quarantine is required for all travelers.
- MOH is working on strengthening risk communications to the public to “Please wear mask to prevent the spread of COVID” by encouraging using masks and social distancing due to reported new sub-variants.
